PARISH PLANNED GIVING PROGRAM

In our parish, we have a wonderful system of Planned Giving. You can contribute regularly to support the vibrancy of our parish community and to allow us to plan and budget for expenses.

If you would like to join the program, you may contribute either via PG envelopes or via direct Debit System through your bank.

Direct Debit System takes very little time to set up. It saves your time and energy and the money is automatically debited through the bank.

We have two collections. The First Collection to support our Priests in our Parish, sick and retired Priests, Priests in needy parishes and our Archbishop.

The Second collection is the Parish's primary source of income. It pays the Church running expenses, like Hosts, Altar Wine, candle, electricity, stationery, equipment, staff wages, repairs, buildings and ground maintenance, evangelization expenses and future Parish development.

No one is poor to the extent of not being able to give, and no one is too rich to receive.

We have a responsibility to support our Church and Priests financially for God's Kingdom.
