# **READINGS**

First Reading

Genesis 22:1-2,9-13,15-18

God put Abraham to the test. 'Abraham, Abraham' he called. 'Here I am' he replied. 'Take your son,' God said 'your only child Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah. There you shall offer him as a burnt offering, on a mountain I will point out to you.'

When they arrived at the place God had pointed out to him, Abraham built an altar there, and arranged the wood. Then he stretched out his hand and seized the knife to kill his son.

But the angel of the Lord called to him from heaven. 'Abraham, Abraham' he said. 'I am here' he replied. 'Do not raise your hand against the boy' the angel said. 'Do not harm him, for now I know you fear God. You have not refused me your son, your only son.' Then looking up, Abraham saw a ram caught by its horns in a bush. Abraham took the ram and offered it as a burnt-offering in place of his son.

The angel of the Lord called Abraham a second time from heaven. 'I swear by my own self – it is the Lord who speaks – because you have done this, because you have not refused me your son, your only son, I will shower blessings on you, I will make your descendants as many as the stars of heaven and the grains of sand on the seashore. Your descendants shall gain possession of the gates of their enemies. All the nations of the earth shall bless themselves by your descendants, as a reward for your obedience.'

# **GOSPEL**

Mark 9:2-10

Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them up a high mountain where they could be alone by themselves. There in their presence he was transfigured: his clothes became dazzlingly white, whiter than any earthly bleacher could make them. Elijah appeared to them with Moses; and they were talking with Jesus. Then Peter spoke to Jesus: 'Rabbi,' he said 'it is wonderful for us to be here; so let us make three tents, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.' He did not know what to say; they were so frightened. And a cloud came, covering them in shadow; and there came a voice from the cloud, 'This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to him.' Then suddenly, when they looked round, they saw no one with them any more but only Jesus.

As they came down from the mountain he warned them to tell no one what they had seen, until after the Son of Man had risen from the dead. They observed the warning faithfully, though among themselves they discussed what 'rising from the dead' could mean.



Welcome to 2024 at St John Bosco College. This year, we are celebrating ten years at the College and have 1202 students from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 11, as well as an OSHC facility and an Aboriginal Families as First Educators Playgroup. Father Mark and Deacon Errol got us off to a great start, when they celebrated a beautiful Mass at St Francis Xavier on Monday January 29 with Xavier Catholic Primary School, Salvado Catholic College and St John Bosco College staff, along with parishioners to commence the year. The same day in the afternoon, Archbishop Timothy Costelloe SDB celebrated the Eucharist and officially commissioned new staff to the Archdiocese of Perth at St Mary's Cathedral. Father Mark and Deacon Errol have celebrated a number of Liturgies in the first four weeks of the term, including the Opening College Liturgy, St Francis de Sales House Liturgy, Ash Wednesday Liturgy to commence the Season of Lent, Year 6 Student Leadership Liturgy and Year 7 Camp Liturgies.

Our innovative building design at St John Bosco has a focus on shared, flexible learning spaces which support best practice, 21st century teaching and learning methods. Our outstanding facilities include an Early Learning Centre, Junior Primary and Upper Primary studios, grass play areas, junior and senior ovals, soccer and hockey pitch and multi-purpose hard court play areas, enclosed Assembly Space, Science Learning Centre, a two-storey Arts and Technology Learning Centre, Library Resource Centre, Middle Learning Centre, Administration and ample parking. We are delighted with our two new buildings: Mazzarello Sport and Recreation Centre and the Senior Learning Centre that consists of 12 classroom studios.
